

Website QA demonstration

A controlled, fictional service-business fixture with intentionally introduced defects

Scope and method

This portfolio sample documents an actual test run against Harbor & Pine Home Services, a local static fixture created only for this demonstration. The blue banner on every fixture page identifies it as a demonstration. The defects were intentionally seeded before testing, then reproduced through the browser. No real client, testimonial, live business, or production system is represented.

The flow under test was: each selected page loads, its primary content renders, internal navigation and the main call to action resolve, mobile navigation responds, responsive content remains visible, and the dummy form produces its local preview state without sending data.

Coverage checklist

Priority key

High: blocks a primary visitor task or access to core navigation. Medium: hides meaningful content or degrades a major layout at an included width. Low: limited inconvenience or polish issue. No critical or security finding was claimed.

Limitations

One desktop browser engine only. Mobile-sized testing used a resized desktop browser viewport, not a physical phone. No cross-browser, accessibility, performance, security, external-site, payment, account, file-upload, or production testing was performed. The dummy form was intentionally non-networking.

Prioritized findings

WQA-01	HIGH	Primary call to action opens a 404 page
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Page	Home: /index.html
Steps	1. Open Home at 1440 x 1000. 2. Select Request a visit.
Expected	A visitor reaches a working request or contact destination.
Actual	The browser navigates to /book.html and the local server returns HTTP 404, File not found.
Impact	Visitors using the primary request link cannot continue toward an inquiry.
Suggested fix	Point the link to an existing contact page or create the intended destination, then retest the final URL.

Error response

Error code: 404

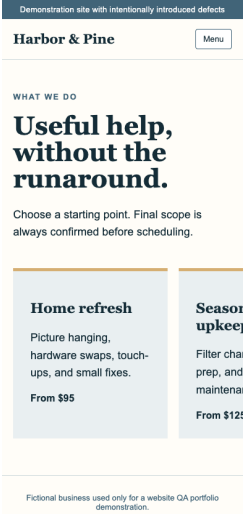
Message: File not found.

Error code explanation: 404 - Nothing matches the given URI.

Evidence: Chromium viewport after selecting Request a visit. The response was HTTP 404.

WQA-02	MEDIUM	Service cards are clipped at the mobile-sized width
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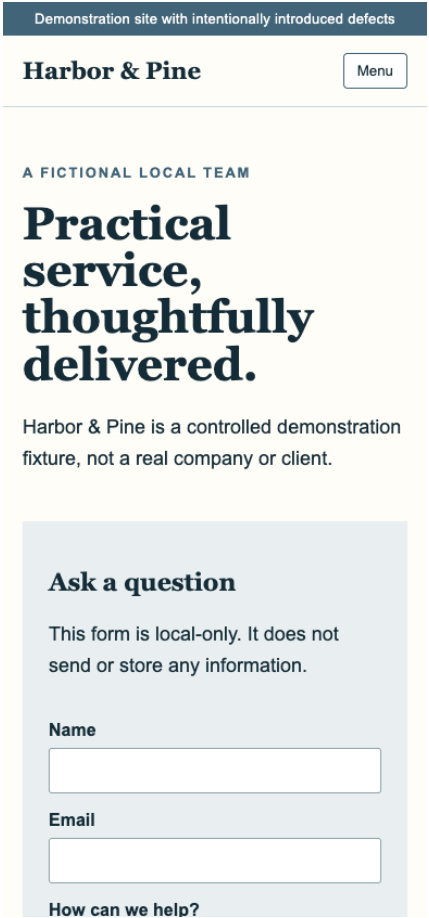
Page	Services: /services.html
Steps	1. Open Services. 2. Resize to 390 x 844. 3. Review the service cards.
Expected	All three cards remain available within the viewport.
Actual	Grid is 820 px wide in a 390 px viewport. The third card has 0 visible horizontal pixels.
Impact	Visitors cannot see the Move-in list service or price.
Suggested fix	Remove the mobile minimum width and use one column at the breakpoint.



Evidence: 390 x 844 viewport. Later cards are outside the visible area.

Prioritized findings

WQA-03	HIGH	Mobile Menu button does not reveal navigation
Page	About: /about.html	
Steps	1. Open About. 2. Resize to 390 x 844. 3. Select Menu.	
Expected	The primary navigation becomes visible and the control reports an expanded state.	
Actual	After the click, aria-expanded remains false, navigation display remains none, and 0 navigation links are visible.	
Impact	Mobile-width visitors cannot use the site navigation from the About page.	
Suggested fix	Add the missing toggle handler, update aria-expanded, and retest opening, closing, and link selection.	



Evidence: 390 x 844 viewport after selecting Menu. No navigation is shown.

Recorded browser evidence

Chromium 152.0.7977.83. The six page-width load checks returned HTTP 200 with one H1 and meaningful main content. The broken destination returned 404. The services body measured 838 px of scroll width against a 390 px client width, and the third card had 0 visible horizontal pixels. After the Menu click, aria-expanded remained false, nav display remained none, and 0 navigation links were visible. The form preview produced its local confirmation and stayed on /about.html.
